The Role

The role will be to support the business in the following areas:

- Identification of waste plastic supplies in the UK. The company is currently involved in a number of waste plastic to oil plants. The plants will take end of waste plastics (PP, HDPE, LDPE) and convert it back into oil. The role will require the individual to contact with waste plastic producers and suppliers to acquire the waste. Each plant will process circa 20,000 tonnes of waste per annum.
- Support Stopford's international projects (France, USA, Far East) with developing a knowledge of waste supply.
- Identification of End-of-Life Tyres Supplies in the UK The company is currently involved in a
 project to convert EFL Tyres into oil and carbon black. The role will be to identify sources of
 EFL tyres in the UK.



- A knowledge of the private and local authority Waste management supply chain in the UK is highly desirable.
- For all projects, the individual should also have an understanding of the technologies used to process waste into feedstock. This should include MRF, Shredders, Conveyors, etc.
- The role will require travel to meet suppliers.
